Turn right onto Dundee Rd.(SR542) Follow SR 542 approx. 4miles just past Elbert Elementary School turn right at the small Polk Community College sign onto Lake Elbert Dr. PCC is diagonally across the lake and can be seen at this point.

From Orlando – I-4 west to US 27 South, past Haines City into Dundee. Turn right onto Dundee Rd. (SR542) Follow for approx. 4miles just past Elbert Elementary School turn right at the small PCC sign onto Lake Elbert Dr. PCC is diagonally across the lake and can be seen at this point.
